Resolution

Petition concerning a resolution of the Parliament “to the effect that the United Nations Secretary-General receives the Dalai Lama”

In its public session on June 19, 1996, the Parliament has complied with the petition of April 26, 1996 from Tibetan Support Group Liechtenstein and passed a resolution in which the Secretary General of the United Nations is requested, in view of the threatened cultural identity of the Tibetan People, to receive the Dalai Lama for talks in order to discuss the following issues:

- Possibility of entering in direct negotiations between the Tibetan Government-in-Exile and the People’s Republic of China;
- Respect for Tibetan religious observance and for the Panchen Lama selected by the Dalai Lama;
- Termination of the destruction of the cultural identity of the Tibetan people.

The President of Parliament was requested to prepare and to transmit the corresponding letter.
